Dear colleagues

At a time when minimally invasive pediatric surgery has evolved as a standard technique in most of our departments, training remains a challenge. Training can be enriched by workshops using animal models similar to clinical conditions. In our experience, small animal models are extremely valuable in this respect. Therefore, we want to invite you to the second international workshop and hands-on course for minimally invasive pediatric surgery using small animal models.

Initially, basic techniques of access, exposure, suturing and knotting in small cavities will be trained on living rats and chickens. The workshop will then focus on specific abdominal, thoracic and even esophageal minimally invasive procedures. We guarantee that participants will be able to perform numerous operations, such as fundoplication, nephrectomy or splenectomy themselves. The facilities at the Aesculap Academy training centers in Berlin and Tuttlingen are excellent and fulfill all needs for such a workshop.

A very limited number of participants will be trained by experts in minimally invasive surgery and the relation in numbers between experts and participants will be optimal.
